HOUSE BILL 1198

1 AN ACT RELATING TO SICK LEAVE OF CERTAIN OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES IN
2 THE OFFICES OF THE CLERKS OF THE SUPERIOR COURT.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6 **Section 1.** All assistant clerks, deputy clerks and other employees of the clerks of
7 the Superior Court of this State and court reporters of the superior courts, who have heretofore
8 been, or shall hereafter be, changed in status from county employees to State employees by
9 reason of the enactment of Chapter 7A of the General Statutes, shall be entitled to transfer sick
10 leave accumulated as a county employee pursuant to any county system and standing to the
11 credit of such employee at the time of such change of status to State employee, not exceeding
12 earned sick leave in an amount totaling 30 work days. Such earned sick leave credit shall be
13 certified to the Administrative Office of the Courts by the official or employee responsible for
14 keeping sick leave records for the county, and the Administrative Office of the Courts shall
15 accord such transferred sick leave credit the same status as if it had been earned as a State
16 employee.

17 **Sec. 2.** All clerks, assistant clerks, deputy clerks and other employees of any court
18 inferior to the superior court which has been or may be abolished by reason of the enactment of
19 Chapter 7A of the General Statutes, who shall thereafter become a State employee by
20 employment in the office of the clerk of the superior court, shall be entitled to transfer sick
21 leave earned as a municipal or county employee pursuant to any municipal or county system in
22 effect on the date said court was abolished, not exceeding earned sick leave in an amount
23 totaling 30 work days. Such earned sick leave credit shall be certified to the Administrative
24 Office of the Courts by the official or employee responsible for keeping sick leave records for
25 the municipality or county, and the Administrative Office of the Courts shall accord such
26 transferred sick leave credit the same status as if it had been earned as a State employee.

27 **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

28 **Sec. 4.** This Act shall become effective upon its ratification and shall be effective
29 retroactively to December 5, 1966, with respect to employees whose status has already been
30 changed by operation of law.
