- A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY THE POLICY IMPLICATIONS OF MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR TEACHERS AND STATE EMPLOYEES.
- 4 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:
 - Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the policy implications of mandatory continuing education for teachers and State employees. The Commission may review the policy administered by all State departments and agencies to determine the need for clarification, technical amendment, repeal, or other change to make the mandatory continuing educational requirements equitable and easy to administer.
 - Sec. 2. The Commission may call upon the Office of Personnel and all pertinent State departments and agencies to cooperate with it in its study of continuing education requirements. The heads of State departments and agencies shall ensure that staff cooperate fully with the Commission.
 - Sec. 3. The Commission may make a final report of its findings and recommendations to the 1989 General Assembly, Regular Session 1990.
 - Sec. 4. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
