A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR VARIOUS GROUPS AND PROJECTS  
IN THE FAYETTEVILLE AREA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of Fayetteville \$10,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to provide transportation for senior citizens.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Spring Lake Community Center Foundation, Inc., of Cumberland County \$10,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Southeastern Cumberland County Rural Community Association, Inc., \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for educational programs, playground equipment, and repairs.

Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina \$7,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to provide funds for the Continuing Education Center at Fayetteville State University.

Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Spring Lake Lifeline Center, Inc., of Cumberland County \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses.

Sec. 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Cumberland Sheltered Workshop, Inc., \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses.

Sec. 7. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Arts Council of Fayetteville/Cumberland County, Inc., \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be used for special projects.

1           Sec. 8. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Sugar and Spice  
2 Day/Night Care for the Elderly in Cumberland County \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal  
3 year to be used for development expenses.

4           Sec. 9. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of  
5 Fayetteville Human Services Department \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for special  
6 programs.

7           Sec. 10. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
