6	able to enjoy the same level of quality in the enforcement of the State's criminal laws;

9	economic ability to pay on the part of any community, agency, or citizen; and				
10	Whereas, the North Carolina Justice Academy, a division of the Department				
11	of Justice, provides important and critical basic and advanced law enforcement training				
12	to local and State agencies and officers; and				
13	Whereas, the demands for the services of the North Carolina Justice Academy				
14	now critically exceed its capacity to meet those demands; Now, therefore,
