A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DAVIE  
2 COUNTY TO ADOPT AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF  
3 FIREARMS OR PELLET GUNS FROM THE ROADWAYS AND RIGHTS-OF-  
4 WAY IN DAVIE COUNTY.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, including G.S.  
8 153A-129 and Article 22 of Chapter 113 of the General Statutes, the Board of  
9 Commissioners of Davie County may enact an ordinance prohibiting the discharge of  
10 any firearm or pellet gun from, on, across, or over the roadway or right-of-way of any  
11 public road, street, or highway in Davie County, except when used in defense of person  
12 or property, or when used pursuant to lawful directions of law enforcement officers.

13 Sec. 2. Any ordinance adopted by the county pursuant to this act may  
14 provide for fines and penalties for violation of the ordinance pursuant to the provisions  
15 of G.S. 153A-123, and any such ordinance shall be enforceable by law enforcement  
16 officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by  
17 other peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction.

18 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
