**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO CHANGE THE MANNER OF ELECTION FOR OFFICE IN THE  
TOWN OF ANDREWS FROM PARTISAN TO NONPARTISAN PLURALITY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Elections for Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Andrews shall be conducted on a nonpartisan plurality basis, with the results determined in accordance with G.S. 163-292.

Sec. 2. Section 2 of Chapter 187, Private Laws of 1933 is repealed.

Sec. 3. Section 3 of Chapter 187, Private Laws of 1933, as amended by Chapter 222, Public-Local Laws of 1937, Chapter 193, Session Laws of 1959, and Section 2 of Chapter 209, Session Laws of 1977, is repealed.

Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
