#### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO EXEMPT THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES AS
  3 REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW FROM THE STATE LAWS CONCERNING
  4 ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
  - Section 1. G.S. 150B-1(d) reads as rewritten:
- 7 "(d) The following are specifically exempted from the provisions of this 8 Chapter: the Administrative Rules Review Commission, the Employment Security 9 Commission, the Industrial Commission, the Occupational Safety and Health Review 10 Board in all actions that do not involve agricultural employers, and the Utilities
- 11 Commission.

- 12 The North Carolina National Guard is exempt from the provisions of this Chapter in 13 exercising its court-martial jurisdiction.
- The Department of Human Resources is exempt from this Chapter in exercising its authority over the Camp Butner reservation granted in Article 6 of Chapter 122C of the
- 16 General Statutes. <u>The Department of Human Resources is also exempt from Article 3</u>
- 17 of this Chapter in complying with the procedural safeguards mandated by the Section
- 18 680 of Part H of P.L. 99-457 as amended (Education of the Handicapped Act
- 19 Amendments of 1986).
- 20 The Department of Correction is exempt from the provisions of this Chapter, except
- 21 for Article 5 of this Chapter and G.S. 150B-13 which shall apply.

1 Articles 2 and 3 of this Chapter shall not apply to the Department of Revenue. 2 Except as provided in Chapter 136 of the General Statutes, Articles 2 and 3 of this 3 Chapter do not apply to the Department of Transportation. 4 Article 4 of this Chapter, governing judicial review of final administrative decisions, 5 shall apply to The University of North Carolina and its constituent or affiliated boards, 6 agencies, and institutions, but The University of North Carolina and its constituent or 7 affiliated boards, agencies, and institutions are specifically exempted from the 8 remaining provisions of this Chapter. Article 4 of this Chapter shall not apply to the State Banking Commission, the Commissioner of Banks, the Savings and Loan Division 9 10 of the Department of Commerce, and the Credit Union Division of the Department of Commerce. 11 12 Article 3 of this Chapter shall not apply to agencies governed by the provisions of 13 Article 3A of this Chapter, as set out in G.S. 150B-38(a). 14 Articles 3 and 3A of this Chapter shall not apply to the Governor's Waste

- 15 Management Board in administering the provisions of G.S. 104E-6.2.
- 16 Article 2 of this Chapter shall not apply to the North Carolina Low-Level
- 17 Radioactive Waste Management Authority in administering the provisions of G.S.
- 18 104G-10 and G.S. 104G-11. Articles 3 and 3A of this Chapter shall not apply to the
- 19 North Carolina Low-Level Radioactive Waste Management Authority in administering
- 20 the provisions of G.S. 104G-9, 104G-10, and 104G-11."
- 21 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989.
