The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
Section 1. G.S. 131D-34(h) reads as rewritten:		
"(h) The Secretary shall establish a penalty review committee	e within the	
Department. Department, which shall review administrative penalties asser-	ssed pursuant	
to this section and pursuant to G.S. 131E-129. The Secretary shall en	sure that the	
Nursing Home/Rest Home Penalty Review Committee established by this	subsection is	
comprised of nine members. At least one member shall be appointed from	m each of the	
following categories:		
(1) A licensed pharmacist;		
(2) A registered nurse experienced in long-term care;		
(3) A representative of a nursing home;		
(4) A representative of a domiciliary home; and		
(5) A public member.		

Each member of the Committee shall serve a term of two years. The initial terms of the members shall commence on the 30th day following ratification of this act. The Secretary shall fill all vacancies. Unexcused absences from three consecutive meetings

Neither the pharmacist, nurse, nor public member appointed under this subsection

nor any member of their immediate families shall be employed by or own any interest in
