1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REPEAL AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ABERDEEN, THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, AND THE TOWN OF SOUTHERN PINES TO EXERCISE EXTRATERRITORIAL PLANNING POWERS FOR TWO MILES FROM THEIR CORPORATE LIMITS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 308, Session Laws of 1985, reads as rewritten:

"Section 1. G.S. 160A-360(a) is amended by adding a new sentence at the end to read:

'The Town of Aberdeen, the Village of Pinehurst and the Town of Southern Pines may exercise the powers granted by this Article for a distance of not more than two miles beyond their corporate limits With the approval of the Moore County Board of Commissioners, any municipality may exercise the powers granted by this Article over any territory within Moore County not under such jurisdiction of another municipality, without regard to the population limitations of this subsection."

- Sec. 2. Section 2 of Chapter 308, Session Laws of 1985 is repealed.
- Sec. 3. Municipal regulations and powers of enforcement over the territory withdrawn from their jurisdiction under Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall remain in effect until (i) the county has adopted such regulations, or (ii) 90 days has elapsed since the effective date of this act, whichever is sooner.
 - Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
