1 A SENATE RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE TEMPORARY RULES OF THE 1989 2 SENATE TO PROVIDE DEADLINES FOR INTRODUCTION AND PASSAGE 3 OF BILLS. 4 Be it resolved by the Senate: 5 Section 1. Rule 41 of the Temporary Rules of the 1989 Senate reads as rewritten: 6 7 "RULE 41. Deadlines on Filing for Introduction of Bills and Resolutions. All bills or resolutions recommended by commissions or committees 8 (a) 9 authorized or directed by act or resolution of the General Assembly to report to the 1989 Regular Session of the General Assembly, or to report prior to convening of that 10 session, must be filed for introduction not later than the last Thursday in February 11 (February 23) of the first year of the biennial session; provided that any such measure 12 submitted to the Bill Drafting Division of the Legislative Services Office by 4:00 p.m. 13 14 on that date and filed for introduction in the Senate before 3:00 p.m. on the next Thursday (March 2) shall be treated as if it had been filed for introduction pursuant to 15 this subsection. 16 17 All Senate bills prepared to be introduced by departments, agencies or (a1) institutions of the State must be filed for introduction in the Senate not later than the 18 third Thursday in April (April 16) of the first year of the biennial session. All bills 19 prepared to be introduced by departments, agencies, or institutions of the State must be 20 21 filed for introduction not later than the second Thursday in March (March 9) of the first vear of the biennial session; provided that any such measure submitted to the Bill 22 Drafting Division of the Legislative Services Office by 4:00 p.m. on that date and filed 23

1	for introduction in the Senate before 3:00 p.m. on the next Thursday (March 16) shall be
2	treated as if it had been filed for introduction pursuant to this subsection.
3	(a2) All Senate local bills must be filed for introduction in the Senate not later
4	than the third Thursday in April (April 16) of the first year of the biennial session;
5	provided that any local measure submitted to the Bill Drafting Division of the
6	Legislative Services Office by 3:00 p.m. by the preceding Wednesday and filed for
7	introduction in the Senate by the next Wednesday (April 22) shall be treated as if it had
8	been filed for introduction pursuant to this subsection. All local bills must be filed for
9	introduction not later than the third Thursday in March (March 16) of the first year of
10	the biennial session; provided that any such measure submitted to the Bill Drafting
11	Division of the Legislative Services Office by 4:00 p.m. on that date and filed for
12	introduction in the Senate before 3:00 p.m. on the next Thursday (March 23) shall be
13	treated as if it had been filed for introduction pursuant to this subsection.
14	(a3) All resolutions, except those honoring the memory of deceased persons, must be
15	filed for introduction in the Senate not later than April 16 of the first year of the biennial
16	session. All resolutions, except those honoring the memory of deceased persons or
17	adjourning the General Assembly must be filed for introduction not later than the first
18	Thursday in May (May 4) of the first year of the biennial session; provided that any
19	such measure submitted to the Bill Drafting Division of the Legislative Services Office
20	by 4:00 p.m. on that date and filed for introduction in the Senate before 3:00 p.m. on the
21	next Thursday (May 11) shall be treated as if it had been filed for introduction pursuant
22	to this subsection.
23	(a4) All public bills except appropriations bills or adjournment resolutions must be filed
24	for introduction by April 30. All public bills not containing appropriations or not
25	requiring to be referred to the Committee on Finance by Rule 42 must be filed for
26	introduction not later than the last Thursday in March (March 30) of the first year of the
27	biennial session; provided that any such measure submitted to the Bill Drafting Division
28	of the Legislative Services Office by 4:00 p.m. on that date and filed for introduction in
29	the Senate before 3:00 p.m. on the next Thursday (April 6) shall be treated as if it had
30	been filed for introduction pursuant to this subsection.
31	(a5) All appropriations bills must be filed for introduction by May 21. All public bills
32	containing appropriations or requiring to be referred to the Committee on Finance by

In order to be eligible for consideration by the Senate during the first regular 1 (b)2 session, all House Bills other than finance bills or those required to be referred to the 3 Committee on Finance by Rule 42, appropriations bills or adjournment resolutions, must be received and read on the floor of the Senate as a message from the House no 4 5 later than May 28-11 of the first regular session; provided that a message from the 6 House received by the next legislative day stating that a bill has passed its third reading and is being engrossed shall comply with the requirements of this subsection and 7 8 provided that the House has a similar rule. 9 (c) No Senate local appropriations bill may be filed for introduction in the Senate

during the second year of the biennial session unless it is filed for introduction on or before June 16 of the second year of the biennial session."
