A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE STAFF NEEDS OF THE SOLID WASTE BRANCH OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Health Services, Solid Waste Management Section, Solid Waste Branch, the sum of one million one hundred eighty-seven thousand seven hundred twenty-five dollars (\$1,187,725) for the 1989-90 fiscal year to establish and provide support for 25 new positions in the Solid Waste Branch and two million seven hundred ninety-two thousand four hundred sixty dollars (\$2,792,460) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to maintain and support the 25 positions created in the 1989-90 fiscal year and to establish and support an additional 25 new positions in the Solid Waste Branch.

These positions shall be used to provide assistance in permitting, to provide technical assistance, to research waste reduction and handling, to establish a clearinghouse of information, to hire a public health educator, to train and educate recycling coordinators and landfill operators, and to propose contracts and grants for new technology and innovative solid waste projects, including projects that avoid or reduce waste streams.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
