- 2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE VILLAGE OF3 SUGAR MOUNTAIN TO DETERMINE WHETHER MIXED BEVERAGES
- 4 MAY BE SOLD IN THAT VILLAGE.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 6, Chapter 18B, of the 7 General Statutes, the Village Council of Sugar Mountain may call an election on the 8 sale of mixed beverages. The ballot propositions shall be those stated in G.S. 18B-9 602(h). If the sale of mixed beverages is approved, purchase-transportation permits shall 10 be issued and sales of liquor shall be made by the Banner Elk ABC system.

- 11 Sec. 2. All of the provisions of Chapter 18B of the General Statutes not 12 inconsistent with Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall apply.
