1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION IN A 1987 ACT WHICH 2 3 REGULATED THE SHINING OF LIGHTS IN DEER AREAS IN THE COUNTIES OF BERTIE AND MADISON. 4 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 249, Session Laws of 1987, reads as 6 7 rewritten: 8 "Sec. 3. Section 1 Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall not be construed to prevent: the lawful hunting of raccoon or opossum during open season with 9 artificial lights designed or commonly used in taking raccoon and 10 opossum at night; 11 the necessary shining of lights by landholders on their own lands; 12 (2) the shining of lights necessary to normal travel by motor vehicles on 13 (3) roads or highways; or 14 the use of lights by campers and others who are legitimately in these 15 (4) areas for other reasons and who are not attempting to attract or to 16 immobilize deer by the use of lights." 17

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
