The Commission shall adopt stringent standards, which may include 1 (c) 2 minimum grade point average, scholastic aptitude test scores, and other standards 3 deemed appropriate by the Commission, to ensure that only the best potential students receive loans under the Nursing Scholars Program. Standards adopted by the 4 5 Commission shall include provisions for ensuring that the qualifications of applicants 6 who are or would be nontraditional students are considered fairly in providing them 7 with opportunities to compete for the loans. Loans under the Nursing Scholars Program 8 shall be awarded only to applicants who meet the standards set by the Commission and 9 who agree to practice nursing in North Carolina upon completion of the nursing 10 education program supported by the loan. The Commission shall develop and administer the Nursing Scholars Program 11 (d)12 in cooperation with nursing schools at institutions approved by the Commission and the 13 North Carolina Board of Nursing. The Nursing Scholars Program shall provide for 14 participants to be exposed to a range of extracurricular activities while in school, which 15 activities shall be aimed at instilling in students a strong motivation to remain in the 16 practice of nursing and to provide leadership for the nursing profession. 17 (e) The Commission may form regional review committees to assist it in 18 identifying the best high school seniors and other applicants for the program. The 19 Commission and the review committees shall make an effort to identify and encourage 20 minority students and students who may not otherwise consider a career in nursing to 21 apply for the Nursing Scholars Program. Upon the naming of recipients of loans from the Nursing Scholars Program, 22 (f)the Commission shall inform the State Education Assistance Authority (SEAA) of its 23 24 decisions. The SEAA shall perform all of the administrative functions necessary to implement this Article, which functions shall include: rule-making, dissemination of 25 information to the public, distribution and receipt of applications for scholarship loans, 26 27 and the functions necessary for the execution, payment, and enforcement of promissory 28 notes required under this Article. 29 "§ 90-171.62. Terms of loans; receipt and disbursement of funds. 30 All scholarship loans shall be evidenced by notes made payable to the State (a) 31 Education Assistance Authority that bear interest at the rate of ten percent (10%) per year beginning 90 days after completion of the nursing education program, or 90 days 32 33 after termination of the scholarship loan, whichever is earlier. The scholarship loan may be terminated upon the recipient's withdrawal from school or by the recipient's 34 35 failure to meet the standards set by the Commission. 36 The State Education Assistance Authority shall forgive the loan if, within (b)seven years after graduation from a nursing education program, the recipient practices 37 38 nursing in North Carolina for one year for every year a scholarship loan was provided. 39 If the recipient repays the scholarship loan by cash payments, all indebtedness shall be 40 repaid within ten years. All funds appropriated to or otherwise received by the Nursing Scholars 41 (c)42 Program for scholarships, all funds received as repayment of scholarship loans, and all interest earned on these funds, shall be placed in a revolving fund. This revolving fund 43 44 may be used only for scholarship loans granted under the Nursing Scholars Program."

1 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of 2 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred thousand 3 dollars (\$100,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year, and the sum of one hundred thousand 4 dollars (\$100,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal year, to be used to enable the State Education 5 Assistance Authority to provide staff and administrative support in carrying out the 6 provisions of this act. 7 Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
