AN ACT TO ALLOW MUNICIPALITIES IN THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM, THE TOWN OF ERWIN, AND FRANKLIN AND LENOIR COUNTIES TO REGULATE THE ABANDONMENT OF JUNKED MOTOR VEHICLES.

20 21 Section 1. G.S. 160A-303.2, as rewritten by Chapter 3, Session Laws of 1989, reads as rewritten:

"§ 160A-303.2. Regulation of abandonment of junked motor vehicles in municipalities in certain counties.

(a) A municipality in Dare, Alamance, Ashe, Bladen, Brunswick, Burke, Cabarrus, Caldwell, Cumberland, Davie, <u>Franklin</u>, Gaston, Guilford, Halifax, Henderson, Iredell, Jackson, <u>Lenoir</u>, Lincoln, Mecklenburg, Moore, New Hanover, Pender, Rockingham, Rowan, Surry, Wake, Wayne, Stokes, Alleghany, Carteret, Columbus or Union <u>Counties—County</u>, the <u>City of Winston-Salem</u>, and the <u>Town of Erwin</u> may by ordinance regulate, restrain or prohibit the abandonment of junked motor vehicles on public grounds and on private property within the municipality's ordinance-making jurisdiction upon a finding that such regulation, restraint or prohibition is necessary and desirable to promote or enhance community, neighborhood or area appearance. The authority granted by this section shall be supplemental to any other authority conferred upon municipalities. Nothing in this section shall be construed to authorize a municipality to require the removal or disposal of a motor vehicle kept or

stored at a bona fide 'automobile graveyard' or 'junkyard' as defined in G.S. 136-143.

For purposes of this	section, the term 'junked motor vehicle' means a vehicle that
does not display a curren	t license plate and that:
(1) Is partia	ally dismantled or wrecked; or
(2) Cannot	be self-propelled or moved in the manner in which it originally
was into	ended to move; or
(3) Is more	e than five years old and appears to be worth less than one
hundred	l dollars (\$100.00).
(b) Any ordina	ince adopted pursuant to this section shall include a prohibition
against removing or disp	posing of any motor vehicle that is used on a regular basis for
business or personal use.	"
