SENATE BILL 558

Short Title: Rape Crisis Funds.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE RAPE CRISIS CENTERS
THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Funds appropriated to the Department of Administration, Council on the Status of Women for the continuation and development of rape and sexual assault programs within the State in the amount of six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal year shall be allocated as follows:

Each program in operation on or before July 1 of each year of the biennium meeting the criteria for eligibility and selections set forth jointly by the North Carolina Coalition Against Sexual Assault and the North Carolina Council on the Status of Women in their request for proposal information may receive an annual grant up to thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000).

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
