2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING CABARRUS COUNTY TO LEVY A ROOM

OCCUPANCY AND TOURISM DEVELOPMENT TAX AND ESTABLISHING A CABARRUS COUNTY TOURISM AUTHORITY.

4 A CABARRUS COUNTY TOURISM AUTHORI'
5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Occupancy Tax Levy. (a) 6 Authorization and Scope. The Cabarrus County Board of Commissioners may by resolution, after not less than 10 7 days' public notice and after a public hearing held pursuant thereto, levy a room 8 occupancy tax of not less than three percent (3%) nor more than five percent (5%) of the 9 gross receipts derived from the rental of any room, lodging, or similar accommodation 10 furnished by a hotel, motel, inn, or similar place within the county that is subject to 11 sales tax imposed by the State under G.S. 105-164.4(3). This tax is in addition to any 12 State or local sales tax. This tax does not apply to accommodations furnished by 13 nonprofit charitable, educational, or religious organizations. 14

Collection. On and after the effective date of the levy of the tax, every 15 (b)operator of a business subject to the tax levied under this act shall collect the tax. This 16 tax shall be collected as part of the charge for furnishing a taxable accommodation. The 17 18 tax shall be stated and charged separately on the sales records, and shall be paid by the purchaser to the operator of the business as trustees for and on account of the county. 19 The tax shall be added to the sales price and shall be passed on to the purchaser instead 20 of being borne by the operator of the business. The county shall design, print, and 21 22 furnish to all appropriate businesses and persons in the county the necessary forms for 23 filing returns and instructions to ensure the full collection of the tax.

1 (c) Administration. The county shall administer a tax levied under this act. A 2 tax levied under this act is due and payable to the Cabarrus County Finance Officer in 3 monthly installments on or before the 15th day of the month following the month in 4 which the tax accrues. Every person, firm, corporation, or association liable for the tax 5 shall, on or before the 15th day of each month, prepare and render a return on a form 6 prescribed by the county. The return shall state the total gross receipts derived in the 7 county in the preceding month from rentals upon which the tax is levied.

8 A return filed with the county finance officer under this act is not a public 9 record as defined by G.S. 132-1 and may not be disclosed except as required by law.

10 (d) Penalties. A person, firm, corporation, or association who fails or refuses to 11 file the return required by this act shall pay a penalty of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each 12 day's omission. In case of failure or refusal to file the return or pay the tax for a period 13 of 30 days after the time required for filing the return or for paying the tax, there shall 14 be an additional tax, as a penalty, of five percent (5%) of the tax due for each additional 15 month or fraction thereof until the tax is paid.

Any person who willfully attempts in any manner to evade a tax imposed under this act or who willfully fails to pay the tax or make and file a return shall, in addition to all other penalties provided by law, be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000), imprisonment not to exceed six months, or both. The board of commissioners may, for good cause shown, compromise or forgive the penalties imposed by this subsection.

(e) Use and Disposition of Revenue. Except as otherwise provided in Section 2(c)(2) of this act, Cabarrus County shall remit one hundred percent (100%) of the net proceeds of the occupancy tax to the Cabarrus County Tourism Authority established under Section 2 of this act. As used in this act, "net proceeds" means gross proceeds less the direct cost to the county of administering and collecting the tax, not to exceed five percent (5%) of the amount collected.

The Authority shall allocate all of the net proceeds of the occupancy tax in a fiscal year, together with all other revenues, if any, received by the Authority from whatever source, the receipt of which by the Authority is hereby authorized, for the development of tourism, support services, tourist-related events, and any other appropriate activities for providing tourism-related facilities or attractions in the county.

The Cabarrus County Finance Officer shall distribute the amounts due theAuthority at least monthly.

(f) Effective Date of Levy. A tax levied under this act shall become effective
on the date specified in the resolution levying the tax. That date must be the first day of
a calendar month, however, and may not be earlier than the first day of the second
month after the date the resolution is adopted.

39 (g) Repeal. A tax levied under this act may be repealed by a resolution 40 adopted by the Cabarrus County Board of Commissioners. Repeal of a tax levied under 41 this act shall become effective on the first day of a month and may not become effective 42 until the end of the fiscal year in which the repeal resolution was adopted. Repeal of a 43 tax levied under this act does not affect a liability for a tax that attached before the
