A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A COMMISSION TO STUDY SALARIES OF MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND JUSTICES AND JUDGES AND MAKE 3 RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE 1990 SESSION OF THE GENERAL 4 5 ASSEMBLY. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 7 Section 1. The Legislative and Judicial Salary Study Commission is created. The Commission shall consist of 15 members appointed by the Governor. No member 8 9 of the General Assembly or Justice or Judge of the General Court of Justice may serve 10 on the Commission. 11 Sec. 2. The Governor shall designate one member of the Commission as
- 12 chairman.

- 13 Sec. 3. The Commission shall study the salaries of the members of the 14 General Assembly and Justices and Judges of the General Court of Justice.
- 15 Sec. 4. The Commission shall submit a report of its findings and 16 recommendations to the General Assembly on or before the first day the 1989 Session 17 of the General Assembly reconvenes in 1990 by filing the report with the President Pro 18 Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Upon filing its 19 report, the Commission shall terminate.
- 20 Sec. 5. The Commission may meet at any time upon the call of the chairman. 21 The Commission may meet in the Legislative Building or the Legislative Office 22 Building.
- Sec. 6. Members of the Commission shall receive per diem, subsistence and
 travel expenses as provided by law.

- Sec. 7. The Commission may contract for professional, clerical, or consultant 1 services. The Governor shall assign professional and clerical staff to assist in the work 2 3 of the Commission. Sec. 8. When a vacancy occurs in the membership of the Commission the 4 5 vacancy shall be filled by the Governor. Sec. 9. All State departments and agencies and local governments and their 6 subdivisions shall furnish the Commission with any information in their possession or 7 8 available to them.
- 9 Sec. 10. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General 10 Assembly for fiscal year 1989-90 the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 11 expenses of the Commission.

Sec. 11. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
