1 **A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**
2 **AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH**
3 **PROGRAMS AND SERVICES.**

4 Whereas, a safe and healthy environment is of paramount importance to
5 economic growth and development; and

6 Whereas, a wide variety of necessary environmental health programs and
7 services have been mandated by the General Assembly, many of which have been
8 delegated to local government; and

9 Whereas, resources to carry out these and other vital environmental health
10 services are not currently available; Now, therefore,

11 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

12 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
13 Human Resources, Division of Health Services, the sum of three million eight hundred
14 thousand dollars (\$3,800,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of three million
15 eight hundred thousand dollars (\$3,800,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to provide high-
16 quality environmental health programs and services at the local level to the people of
17 the State.

18 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
