The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
Section 1. G.S. 96-14 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:	

- 7"(12)Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter, no otherwise<br/>eligible individual shall be denied benefits for any weeks if it is<br/>determined by the Commission that such individual is, at the time such<br/>claim is filed, unemployed because he left work solely as a result of a<br/>lack of work caused by the bankruptcy of his employer."
- 12 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
