5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 143-49(6) reads as rewritten:

To make available to nonprofit corporations operating charitable 7 "(6) hospitals, to local nonprofit community sheltered workshops or centers 8 that meet standards established by the Division of Vocational 9 Rehabilitation of the Department of Human Resources, to private 10 nonprofit agencies licensed or approved by the Department of Human 11 Resources as child placing agencies or residential child-care facilities. 12 and to counties, cities, towns, governmental entities and other 13 subdivisions of the State and public agencies thereof in the expenditure 14 of public funds, the services of the Department of Administration in 15 the purchase of materials, supplies and equipment under such rules, 16 regulations and procedures as the Secretary of Administration may 17 adopt. In adopting rules and regulations any or all provisions of this 18 Article may be made applicable to such purchases and contracts made 19 through the Department of Administration, and in addition the rules 20 and regulations shall contain a requirement that payment for all such 21 purchases be made in accordance with the terms of the contract. Prior 22 to adopting rules and regulations under this subdivision, the Secretary 23
