A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO STUDY WHETHER THE STATE SHOULD REQUIRE A LICENSE TO
SELL FISH TAKEN FROM COASTAL FISHING WATERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. In addition to the powers and functions set forth in Article 12F of Chapter 120 of the General Statutes, the Joint Legislative Commission on Seafood and Aquaculture shall study whether the state should require a license to sell fish taken from coastal fishing waters and shall make recommendations to the General Assembly including, but not limited to, requiring licenses, license fees, implementation and collection of fees, and use of proceeds from fees. The Commission shall report its findings and recommendations to the 1992 General Assembly.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
