**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO STUDY  
AND RECOMMEND METHODS FOR ENCOURAGING STATE EMPLOYEES  
TO USE PUBLIC TRANSIT IN COMMUTING TO WORK.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Department of Administration shall, in consultation with the Department of Transportation, study and recommend methods for encouraging State employees to use public transit, including carpools and vanpools, in commuting to work. The Department of Administration shall report its findings and recommendations to the 1993 General Assembly by March 15, 1993.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
