A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA 4-H 3 PROGRAM. 4 Whereas, the North Carolina 4-H Camps are owned by the State, or deeded to 5 an entity of the State, North Carolina State University; and Whereas, no appropriated funds presently are allocated for the maintenance of 6 7 these facilities; and 8 Whereas, those facilities provide educational and recreational services to 9 more than 10,000 North Carolina families each year representative of the State population; and 10 Whereas, these properties represent capital assets of more than \$7,000,000 11 contributed by citizen volunteers; Now, therefore, 12 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 13 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of 14 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred thousand 15 dollars (\$100,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year for the North Carolina 4-H Development 16 Fund at North Carolina State University for camp operation funds for the North 17 Carolina 4-H Camp Program. 18 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992. 19
