Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction, Division of Adult Probation and Parole, for the 1991-92 fiscal year the sum of \$485,000 to be used as a grant-in-aid for a pilot program at Southern Appalachian Mainstream, Inc., a community-based residential program for offenders who are leaving the Division of Prisons and who are in need of residence plans, community service jobs, and/or social readiness skills. Southern Appalachian Mainstream, Inc., shall provide a quarterly report to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on the expenditure of State funds and the effectiveness of the program, including information on the number of clients served and the number of clients who successfully complete the program while residing at Southern Appalachian Mainstream.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
