CHAPTER 286 HOUSE BILL 412

AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE RECYCLING OF HAZARDOUS WASTE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 130A-294.1(1) reads as rewritten:

"(1) A commercial hazardous waste storage, treatment, or disposal facility shall pay annually, in addition to the fees applicable to all hazardous waste storage, treatment, or disposal facilities, a single tonnage charge of one dollar and seventy-five cents (\$1.75) per ton or any part thereof of hazardous waste stored, treated, or disposed of at the facility. <u>A manufacturing facility that receives hazardous waste generated from the use of a product typical of its manufacturing process for the purpose of recycling is exempt from this tonnage charge. A facility must have a permit issued under this <u>Article which includes the recycling activity and specifies the type and amount of waste allowed to be received from off-site for recycling.</u>"</u>

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 13th day of June, 1991.
