A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO CREATE A CIVIL PENALTY FOR OPERATING OVERSIZE
VEHICLES OR COMBINATIONS OF VEHICLES WITHOUT OR IN
VIOLATION OF A PERMIT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 20-119.1. Operation of vehicle or combination of vehicles without or in violation of oversize permit.

(a) If a vehicle or combination of vehicles is operated in this State without a special permit issued under G.S. 20-119 for oversized vehicles, or in violation of the restrictions stated on that special permit, the owner or registrant of the vehicle or combination of vehicles shall be subject to a civil penalty of two hundred dollars (\$200.00).

(b) The civil penalty provided in subsection (a) of this section shall constitute the sole penalty for operating a vehicle or combination of vehicles without a valid oversize permit or in violation of restrictions stated on the oversize permit issued for that vehicle or combination of vehicles. Procedures to contest the civil penalty shall be the same as provided by G.S. 20-91.1."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
