## CHAPTER 131 HOUSE BILL 441

## AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT TWO AWARDS FOR PREEMINENT ACCOMPLISHMENT MAY BE MADE TO NATIVE-BORN NORTH CAROLINIANS RESIDING OUTSIDE THE STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 140A-3 reads as rewritten:

## "§ 140A-3. Annual award to native awards to natives living outside State.

One award shall <u>Awards may be made</u> annually be made to a native-born North Carolinian, <u>North Carolinians</u>, living outside of North Carolina, for preeminent accomplishment in one not more than two of the above fields of creative endeavor."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 27th day of May, 1991.
