3	CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES AND TO MAKE OTHER CHANGES TO

5	CONTROL OF ANABOLIC STEROIDS.		
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
7	Section 1. G.S. 90-91(k) reads as rewritten:		
8	"(k) Any anabolic steroids, unless dispensed with a prescription by a registered		
9	pharmacist. Anabolic steroids. The term 'anabolic steroid' means any material,		
10	compound, mixture, or preparation containing an anabolic steroid, drug or hormonal		
11	substance, chemically and pharmacologically related to testosterone (other than		
12	estrogens, progestins, and corticosteroids) that promotes muscle growth, including, but		
13	not limited to, the following:		
14	1. Methandrostenolone,		
15	2. Stanozolol,		
16	3. Ethylestrenol,		
17	4. Nandrolone phenpropionate,		
18	5. Nandrolone deconoate,		
19	6. Testosterone propionate, and		
20	7. Chorionic gonadotropin. gonadotropin,
