CHAPTER 137 HOUSE BILL 680

AN ACT TO EXEMPT BURKE COUNTY FROM CERTAIN STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COUNTY DETENTION FACILITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The County of Burke may contract for the design and construction of a county detention facility to prevent or relieve overcrowding at its current facility without being subject to the requirements of G.S. 143-128, 143-129, 143-131, and 143-132.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification, and expires July 1, 1992. In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 27th day of May, 1991.
