- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. G.S. 160A-58.4 reads as rewritten:

7 "§ 160A-58.4. Extraterritorial powers.

8 Satellite corporate limits shall not-be considered a part of the city's corporate limits 9 for the purposes of extraterritorial land-use regulation pursuant to G.S. 160A-360, or 10 <u>but not for purposes of abatement of public health nuisances pursuant to G.S. 160A-193.</u> 11 However, a city's power to regulate land use pursuant to Chapter 160A, Article 19, or to 12 abate public health nuisances pursuant to G.S. 160A-193, shall be the same within 13 satellite corporate limits as within its primary corporate limits."

14 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding G.S. 160A-360, no approval from or agreement with 15 Iredell County shall be required prior to the exercise of authority under G.S. 160A-360 16 by the Town of Mooresville in an area not to exceed one mile from the Town's satellite
