AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FROM THE WORKER TRAINING TRUST FUND FOR THE 1992-93 FISCAL YEAR.

- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. Section 141 of Chapter 689 of the 1991 Session Laws reads as 6 rewritten:

7 "Sec. 141. (a) There is appropriated from the Worker Training Trust Fund to the 8 Employment Security Commission of North Carolina the sum of \$5,459,673 for the 9 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$6,059,673-\$5,839,964 for the 1992-93 fiscal year for 10 the operation of local offices at the 1986-87 level of service.

11 (b) Notwithstanding G.S. 96-5(c), there is appropriated from the Special 12 Employment Security Administration Fund to the Employment Security Commission of 13 North Carolina, the sum of \$2,000,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of 14 \$2,000,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year for administration of the Veterans Employment 15 Program, Employment Services Program, and Unemployment Insurance Program.

16 (c) Supplemental federal funds or other additional funds received by the 17 Employment Security Commission for similar purposes shall be expended prior to the 18 expenditure of funds appropriated by this section.

(d) Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 96-5(f), there is appropriated from the
Worker Training Trust Fund to the following agencies the following sums for the 199192 and the 1992-93 fiscal years for the following purposes:

21		the 1992-93 fiscal year shall be used to increase the annual funding for
