SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 1139*

A JOINT RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE ISSUE OF REQUIRING OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS WHO ATTEND PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN NORTH CAROLINA TO PAY THE FULL COST OF THEIR EDUCATION.

Whereas, the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee reviewed information regarding the cost to the State of North Carolina of educating out-of-state students in the public schools of North Carolina; and

Whereas, in the course of its review, the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee determined that there may be many unanticipated consequences both for children and for school systems if these children are required to pay the full costs of their education; and

Whereas, the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee determined that the number of out-of-state children attending school in North Carolina has not yet been accurately determined; and

Whereas, the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee found that it would be appropriate to look at tuition policies in other states, especially the home states of these out-of-state students, before changing the policy for North Carolina; Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:

Section 1. The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall study the issue of requiring out-of-state students who attend public schools in North Carolina to pay the full cost of their education. The Committee shall report the results of its study to the 1993 General Assembly.

Sec. 2. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
