#### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

# 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT 3 PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE STATE'S MINORITY 4 COMMUNITY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North 7 Carolina Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., the sum of one million four 8 hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year for allocation to local 9 community development corporations. These funds shall be used to support community 10 economic development projects and activities within the State's minority community.

Of the funds appropriated in this section, one million one hundred fifty 11 12 thousand dollars (\$1,150,000) shall be used for direct grants to the local community development corporations that have previously received State funds for this purpose to 13 support operations and project activities, one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) shall 14 be available for direct grants to local community development corporations that have 15 not previously received State funds for this purpose, and one hundred fifty thousand 16 dollars (\$150,000) shall be a direct grant to the North Carolina Association of 17 18 Community Development Corporations, seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) of which shall be used to support operations and project activities, and seventy-five 19 thousand dollars (\$75,000) of which shall be used to fund the North Carolina 20 Association of Community Development Corporations' loan fund. If funds allocated 21 22 under this subsection for direct grants to community development corporations that have previously received State Funds have not been committed for direct grants by the 23 North Carolina Rural Economic Development Center by March 31, 1993, then such 24

uncommitted funds shall be used for direct grants to community development 1 2 corporations that have not previously received State funds. The North Carolina Rural 3 Economic Development Center, Inc., and the North Carolina Association of Community Development Corporations shall establish, and the North Carolina Rural Economic 4 5 Development Center, Inc., shall implement, performance-based criteria for determining 6 which community development corporations will receive a grant and the grant amounts.

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(b) The North Carolina Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., shall 8 report quarterly to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on 9 the use of the funds allocated in this subsection.

10 (c) For purposes of this section, the term "community development corporation" means a nonprofit corporation, chartered pursuant to Chapter 55A of the 11 12 General Statutes and tax-exempt pursuant to section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue 13 Code, whose primary mission is to develop and improve low-income communities and 14 neighborhoods through economic and related development, whose activities and 15 decisions are initiated, managed, and controlled by the constituents of those local 16 communities, and whose primary function is to act as deal maker and packager of 17 projects and activities that will increase their constituencies' opportunities to become 18 owners, managers, and producers of small businesses, affordable housing, and jobs 19 designed to produce positive cash flow and curb blight in the target community.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State 20 21 Budget and Management, the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 22 1992-93 fiscal year for allocation to the Land Loss Prevention Project, Inc., to provide 23 free legal representation to low-income financially distressed small farmers. The Land 24 Loss Prevention Project, Inc., shall not use these funds to represent farmers who have 25 income and assets that would make them financially ineligible for legal services pursuant to Title 45, Part 1611 of the Code of Federal Regulations. The Land Loss 26 27 Prevention Project, Inc., shall report quarterly to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on the use of these funds. 28

29 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State 30 Budget and Management, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for 31 the 1992-93 fiscal year for allocation to the North Carolina Coalition of Farm and Rural Families, Inc., for its Small Farm Economic Development Project. These funds shall be 32 used to foster economic development within the State's rural farm communities by 33 34 offering financial, marketing, and technical assistance to small and limited resource 35 farmers. The North Carolina Coalition of Farm and Rural Families, Inc., shall report 36 quarterly to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on the use 37 of these funds.

38 Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State 39 Budget and Management, the sum of three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year for allocation to the North Carolina Institute for Minority 40 Economic Development, Inc., to foster minority economic development within the State 41 42 through policy analysis, information and technical assistance, and resource expansion. The North Carolina Institute for Minority Economic Development, Inc., shall research 43 44 and identify key issues affecting the economic well-being of the State's ethnic minority

1 community and issue annual reports with appropriate recommendations; provide 2 information and technical assistance to organizations with minority economic 3 development-based projects in common areas of need and interests; develop a resource 4 bank of data and information, facilitate training in appropriate areas of need, and 5 provide technical assistance to minority construction contractors. The North Carolina 6 Institute for Minority Economic Development, Inc., shall report quarterly to the Joint 7 Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on the use of these funds.

8 Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina 9 Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) 10 for the 1992-93 fiscal year for allocation to local minority-owned and operated credit unions, and for allocation to the North Carolina Minority Credit Union Support Center, 11 12 Inc. These funds shall be used to foster minority economic development within the 13 State by increasing the lending capacity of minority-owned and operated credit unions. 14 Ninety percent (90%) of these funds shall be allocated to local minority-owned and 15 operated credit unions for capitalization of economic development and housing loans, 16 and ten percent (10%) of these funds shall be allocated to the North Carolina Minority 17 Credit Union Support Center, Inc., for operational and administrative support. The 18 North Carolina Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., shall report quarterly to the 19 Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on the use of these funds.

20 Sec. 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina 21 Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., the sum of six hundred fifty thousand 22 dollars (\$650,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year to be used to expand the Microenterprise 23 Loan Program. Of these funds, no less than four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) 24 shall be used as loan loss reserves and no more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars 25 (\$250,000) shall be used to cover operational costs. These funds are to be matched on the basis of two dollars of non-State funds for every one dollar of State funds. The 26 27 North Carolina Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., shall report quarterly to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on the use of these funds. 28

Sec. 7. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina 29 30 Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) 31 for the 1992-93 fiscal year to be used for its expenses in administering this section. 32 The Office of State Budget and Management shall allot the funds pursuant to Sections 5 and 6 of this act in increments of not less than two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) 33 34 and not more than three hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$325,000) within 30 35 working days of the receipt of the Center's request for the funds. Requests shall include a commitment of any required matching funds from non-State funds. The North 36 37 Carolina Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., shall distribute the funds pursuant 38 to Sections 5 and 6 of this act immediately upon allotment by the Office of State Budget 39 and Management.

Sec. 8. The North Carolina Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., shall
not distribute funds under Sections 1, 5, and 6 of this act unless and until the entities
eligible for funds under those sections have met the requirements of G.S. 143-6.1.
Sec. 9. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.

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
