2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE A COUNTY TO TRANSFER THE SCRAP TIRE FEES 3 RECEIVED BY THE COUNTY TO ANY UNIT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT 4 THAT OPERATES THE SCRAP TIRE DISPOSAL SITE, WHEN A COUNTY

DESIGNATES A UNIT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT OTHER THAN THAT

COUNTY TO PROVIDE A SITE FOR THE DISPOSAL OF SCRAP TIRES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 130A-309.54(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) If a scrap tire disposal site provided by any county pursuant to G.S. 130A-309.58 is other than a site operated by the county, the county shall transfer the scrap tire disposal fees received by the county under G.S. 130A-309.55 and G.S. 130A-309.56 to any unit of local government that operates the scrap tire site. The fees imposed by G.S. 130A-55 and G.S. 130A-56 shall be used by each county unit of local government that operates a scrap tire disposal site for the disposal of scrap tires pursuant to the provisions of this Part or for the abatement of a nuisance pursuant to G.S. 130A-309.60."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991.
