SENATE BILL 167

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE CLAY, GRAHAM, AND SWAIN COUNTIES TO COLLECT CERTAIN FEES IN THE SAME MANNER AS AD VALOREM TAXES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 153A-293 reads as rewritten:

"§ 153A-293. Collection of fees in certain counties.

(a) A county may provide that any fee imposed under G.S. 153A-292 may be billed with the ad valorem taxes, may be payable in the same manner as ad valorem taxes, and, in the case of nonpayment, may result in the imposition of a lien on the property owner's real property in the same manner as ad valorem taxes.

(b) This section applies to Alleghany, Anson, Ashe, Burke, Caswell, Clay, Cleveland, Duplin, Gaston, Graham, Lee, Lenoir, Montgomery, Polk, Richmond, Robeson, Swain, Transylvania, Washington, Watauga, and Wayne Counties only."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
