CHAPTER 183
SENATE BILL 218

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO CANCEL THE REGISTRATION AND TITLE OF CERTAIN VEHICLES AND DELETING AN OBSOLETE REQUIREMENT CONCERNING INFORMATION GIVEN IN AN APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF TITLE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-110 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(1) The Division may rescind and cancel the registration and certificate of title of a vehicle when presented with evidence, such as a sworn statement, that the vehicle has been transferred to a person who has failed to get a new certificate of title for the vehicle as required by G.S. 20-73. A person may submit evidence to the Division by mail."

Sec. 2. G.S. 20-52(a)(3) reads as rewritten:

"(3) A statement of the applicant's title and of all liens ~~or encumbrances~~ upon ~~said vehicle and~~ the vehicle, including the names and addresses of all lienholders in the order of their priority, and the amount, date and nature of the security agreement; each lien;".

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 3rd day of June, 1991.
