- 2 AN ACT TO MAKE A TECHNICAL AMENDMENT REGARDING THE3 RENUNCIATION OF AN INTESTATE INTEREST AS RECOMMENDED BY
- 4 THE GENERAL STATUTES COMMISSION.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 31B-3 is hereby amended by adding a new subsection thereto 7 to read as follows:

8 "(<u>c</u>) In the event that the decedent dies intestate, or the ownership or succession to 9 property or an interest is to be determined as though a decedent had died intestate, the 10 property or interest renounced shall be distributed to the persons who would be heirs of 11 the renouncer other than the renouncer's spouse in accordance with the provisions of

12 Chapter 29 of the General Statutes, Intestate Succession, as if the renouncer died

- 13 intestate immediately after the decedent."
- 14 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to any renunciation 15 made on or after that date.
