A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE SUNSET ON OPEN SEASONS FOR TAKING FOXES
WITH WEAPONS AND BY TRAPPING IN CERTAIN COUNTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 726 of the 1987 Session Laws, as amended
by Chapter 504 of the 1989 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 3. This act shall become effective upon ~~ratification and shall expire on July 1,~~
~~1991.~~ ratification."

Sec. 2. This act applies only to Brunswick, Caswell, Clay, Graham,
Henderson, Hyde, Johnston, Macon, Sampson, Stokes, and Tyrrell Counties.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
