SENATE BILL 584

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF DURHAM TO PROVIDE OFF-STREET
2 PARKING AT REDUCED RATES OR WITHOUT CHARGE TO PERSONS
3 RESIDING IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA OF THE CITY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 160A-314 is amended by adding two new subsections to
7 read:

8 "(a1) A schedule of rents, rates, fees, and charges established by a city for use of
9 off-street parking facilities and systems may provide for such use at no charge or at
10 reduced rates by customers residing in housing units located in the downtown area of
11 the city. The city council shall define the 'downtown area of the city' for purposes of
12 this subsection. Eligibility under this subsection may be based on the number of
13 housing units, the number of customers residing in the housing units, or such other
14 method or system of classification as may be determined by the city council.

15 (a2) It is the intent of subsection (a1) to provide a means to encourage the
16 rejuvenation and revitalization of the downtown area of the city and thereby promote
17 sound urban development and the general welfare of the city, which are hereby declared
18 to be lawful public purposes of the city."

19 Sec. 2. This act applies only to the City of Durham.

20 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
