- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. G.S. 90-29(b) reads as rewritten:
- 6 "(b) A person shall be deemed to be practicing dentistry in this State who does, 7 undertakes or attempts to do, or claims the ability to do any one or more of the 8 following acts or things which, for the purposes of this Article, constitute the practice of 9 dentistry:
- 10 (1) Diagnoses, treats, operates, or prescribes for any disease, disorder, pain, deformity, injury, deficiency, defect, or other physical condition 11 12 of the human teeth, gums, alveolar process, jaws, maxilla, mandible, or adjacent tissues or structures of the oral cavity; 13 Removes stains, accretions or deposits from the human teeth; 14 (2)15 (3) Extracts a human tooth or teeth; Performs any phase of any operation relative or incident to the (4) 16 replacement or restoration of all or a part of a human tooth or teeth 17 18 with any artificial substance, material or device; Corrects the malposition or malformation of the human teeth; 19 (5) Administers an anesthetic of any kind in the treatment of dental or oral 20 (6)
- Administers an anesthetic of any kind in the deathetic of dental of of all
 diseases or physical conditions, or in preparation for or incident to any
 operation within the oral cavity; provided, however, that this

7	(8)	Makes, builds, constructs, furnishes, processes, reproduces, repairs,

9		prosthetic denture, bridge, appliance, corrective device, or other
10		structure designed or constructed as a substitute for a natural human
11		tooth or teeth or as an aid in the treatment of the malposition or
12		malformation of a tooth or teeth, except to the extent the same may
13		lawfully be performed in accordance with the provisions of G.S. 90-
14		29.1 and 90-29.2;
15	(9)	Uses a Roentgen or X-ray machine or device for dental treatment or
16		diagnostic purposes, or gives interpretations or readings of dental
17		Roentgenograms or X rays;
18	(10)	Performs or engages in any of the clinical practices included in the
19		curricula of recognized dental schools or colleges;
20	(11)	Owns, manages, supervises, controls or conducts, either himself or by
21		and through another person or other persons, any enterprise wherein
22		any one or more of the acts or practices set forth in subdivisions (1)
23		through (10) above are done, attempted to be done, or represented to
24		be done;
25	(12)	Uses, in connection with his name, any title or designation, such as
26		'dentist,' 'dental surgeon,' 'doctor of dental surgery,' 'D.D.S.,'
27		'D.M.D.,' or any other letters, words or descriptive matter which, in
28		any manner, represents him as being a dentist able or qualified to do or
29		perform any one or more of the acts or practices set forth in
30		subdivisions (1) through (10) above;
31	(13)	Represents to the public, by any advertisement or announcement, by or
32	()	through any media, the ability or qualification to do or perform any of
33		the acts or practices set forth in subdivisions (1) through (10) above."
