3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	Section 1. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
5	section to read:
6	" <u>§ 20-81.12. Collegiate insignia plates.</u>
7	(a) The Division shall develop a collegiate license plate as provided in this
8	section for State and independent universities, domiciled in this State, and shall issue a
9	collegiate license plate to the owner of any motor vehicle, except a vehicle registered
10	under the International Registration Plan or a commercial truck, upon application and
11	payment of the appropriate fees.
12	(b) An owner who desires a collegiate insignia plate shall make application
13	for such plates on forms which shall be provided by the Division and pay the sum of
14	twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) annually, which shall be in addition to the regular motor
15	vehicle registration fee.
16	(c) An application for a collegiate insignia license plate may be made at any
17	time during the year. If the application is made for a collegiate insignia license plate to
18	replace an existing current valid plate, the specialty plate shall be issued with
19	appropriate decals attached. The fee prescribed in subsection (b) of this section must be
20	paid. No refund shall be made to the applicant for any unused portion remaining on the
21	original plate. When application is made for a collegiate insignia license at the
22	beginning of the applicant's registration period, the normal registration fee must be paid
23	in addition to the fee prescribed in subsection (b) of this section.

2	placed in a separate fund designated the 'Collegiate Plate Fund'. The additional fee		
3	shall be distributed as follows:		
4	<u>(1)</u>	Ten dollars (\$10.00) of the special fee shall be used to cover the cost	
5		of the plates, plus budgetary requirements for handling and issuance to	
6		be determined by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles. After	
7		deducting these administrative costs, any remaining monies derived	
8		from this ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be periodically transferred to the	
9		Department of Transportation pursuant to G.S. 20-81.3(c)(2).	
10	<u>(2)</u>	Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) of the special fee shall be distributed to the	
11		Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina for all State	
12		universities and to the Board of Trustees for each independent college	
13		or university in the State in proportion to the number of collegiate	
14		plates sold representing that institution for use for academic	
15		enhancement.
