5	WATERSHEDS.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. Part 2 of Article 9 of Chapter 130A of the General Statutes is
8	amended by adding a new section to read:
9	"§ 130A-295.2. Limitations on permits for sanitary landfills in water supply
10	watersheds.
11	(a) No permit shall be issued for a new sanitary landfill for the disposal of
12	nonhazardous solid waste that would be located within the watershed of any of the
13	surface waters of the State that are assigned water supply classifications WS-I, WS-II,
14	or WS-III under rules adopted by the Environmental Management Commission.
15	(b) No permit shall be issued for a new sanitary landfill or for the expansion of
16	an existing sanitary landfill for the disposal of nonhazardous solid waste that would be
17	or is located within the watershed of any of the surface waters of the State that were
18	assigned water supply classifications WS-I or WS-II as of 30 June 1990 under rules
19	adopted by the Environmental Management Commission and in effect on 30 June 1990,
20	or within the watershed of any of the surface waters of the State for which on 30 June
21	1990 there was pending before the Environmental Management Commission a petition
22	for the classification or reclassification of such waters to WS-I or WS-II."
23	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
