3. Fiscal/Revenue Assumptions

At the present time, any person 21 years of age or older who is convicted of an offense under G.S. 90-95(a)(1) (manufacture, sell, deliver, or possess with intent to manufacture, sell, or deliver a controlled substance) on property used for an elementary or secondary school or within 300 feet of such property is punished as a Class E felon. In FY 1989-90, there were no charges of this offense within the 300 foot boundary, and it appears doubtful that extending the boundary to 1,000 feet would have any appreciable impact on the court system.
