A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STUDY OF TAX CREDITS FOR BUSINESSES THAT
2 PURCHASE PRODUCTS WITH RECYCLED CONTENT OR ANY OTHER TAX
3 INCENTIVES THAT WOULD SERVE TO PROMOTE THE DEVELOPMENT
4 OF MARKETS FOR RECYCLABLES.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. The Environmental Review Commission or any Legislative
8 Research Commission study committee on the subject of solid waste shall study the
9 feasibility and the desirability of establishing tax credits for businesses that purchase
10 products with recycled content or any other tax incentives that would serve to promote
11 the development of markets for recyclables in this State. The Commission or committee
12 shall consider what other states are doing to encourage the development of markets for
13 recyclables. The Commission or committee shall report its findings and
14 recommendations on this subject to the 1995 General Assembly and may make an
15 interim report to the 1994 Session of the 1993 General Assembly.

16 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
