The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative Services Commission the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1993-95 biennium for the Mountain Area Study Commission.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
