A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ADD TWO ADDITIONAL MEMBERS TO THE SITE-BASED MANAGEMENT TASK FORCE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 115C-238.7(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) There is created the Task Force on Site-Based Management within the Department of Public Instruction.

The Task Force shall be composed of ~~45~~17 members appointed as follows:

- (1) The Superintendent of Public Instruction;
- (2) One member of the State Board of Education appointed by the State Board of Education;
- (3) Two members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;
- (4) Two members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;
- (5) One member of a local board of education appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate after receiving recommendations from The North Carolina State School Boards Association, Inc.;
- (6) One member of a local board of education appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives after receiving recommendations from The North Carolina State School Boards Association, Inc.;
- (7) One local school superintendent appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate after receiving recommendations from the North Carolina Association of School Administrators;

- 1 (8) One local school superintendent appointed by the Speaker of the  
2 House of Representatives after receiving recommendations from the  
3 North Carolina Association of School Administrators;  
4 (9) One school principal appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the  
5 Senate after receiving recommendations from the Tar Heel Association  
6 of Principals/Assistant Principals;  
7 (10) One school principal appointed by the Speaker of the House of  
8 Representatives after receiving recommendations from the Tar Heel  
9 Association of Principals/Assistant Principals;  
10 (11) One school teacher appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the  
11 Senate after receiving recommendations from the North Carolina  
12 Association of Educators, Inc., the North Carolina Federation of  
13 Teachers, and the Professional Educators of North Carolina, Inc.;
- 14 (12) One school teacher appointed by the Speaker of the House of  
15 Representatives after receiving recommendations from the North  
16 Carolina Association of Educators, Inc., the North Carolina Federation  
17 of Teachers, and the Professional Educators of North Carolina, Inc.;
- 18 ~~and~~  
19 (13) The Director of the Task Force on Site-Based Management, appointed  
20 by the Superintendent of Public Instruction in accordance with  
21 subsection (d) of this ~~section~~-section;
- 22 (14) One parent member appointed by the Superintendent of Public  
23 Instruction; and  
24 (15) One at-large member appointed by the Superintendent of Public  
25 Instruction.

26 Members of the Task Force shall serve for two-year terms.

27 All members of the Task Force shall be voting members. Vacancies in the appointed  
28 membership shall be filled by the officer who made the initial appointment. The  
29 Director of the Task Force on Site-Based Management shall serve as chair of the Task  
30 Force.

31 Members of the Task Force shall receive travel and subsistence expenses in  
32 accordance with the provisions of G.S. 120-3.1, G.S. 138-5, and G.S. 138-6."

33 Sec. 2. Members appointed in accordance with this act shall serve until  
34 September 1, 1994, and shall be eligible for reappointment. Successive appointments  
35 shall be for two-year terms.

36 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
