- Provide for the hiring of personnel necessary to implement beaver 1 (5) 2 damage control activities, administer the pilot program, and set salaries 3 of personnel; Evaluate the costs and benefits of the program that might be applicable 4 (6) 5 elsewhere in North Carolina. 6 Upon the conclusion of the pilot program on December 1, 1994, the Board shall 7 issue a report to the Wildlife Resources Commission on the results of the program,
 - including recommendations on the feasibility of continuing the program in participating counties and the desirability of expanding the program into other counties."

 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Wildlife Resources Commission the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal
- year to provide the State share necessary to expand the beaver damage control pilot program established in Section 69 of Chapter 1044 of the 1991 Session Laws to Onslow County. These funds shall be matched by four thousand dollars (\$4,000) of local funds
