A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SUPPORTIVE HOUSING, AS RECOMMENDED BY COALITION 2001.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, the sum of six million four hundred thousand dollars (\$6,400,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be placed in a reserve to develop 100 units of service-enriched housing for homeless and at-risk adults, as recommended by Coalition 2001. These units shall be for people with special needs, primarily people with mental illness, alcohol or drug dependence, developmental disabilities, and HIV-AIDS. These units shall be developed by the Division in cooperation with the North Carolina Housing Finance Agency and the national nonprofit Corporation for Supportive Housing.

(b) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, the sum of three million four hundred three thousand three hundred forty-six dollars (\$3,403,346) to be placed in a reserve to provide rental subsidies to special-needs tenants of the units built pursuant to subsection (a) of this section.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
