The State Board of Education, in consultation with the Board of The University of North Carolina, the North Carolina High School riation, Inc., and The North Carolina Coaches Association, shall study the supply and demand of coaches in the North Carolina Public Schools mmendations on ways to improve the supply and quality of coaches. As ecommendations, the State Board of Education shall:	
(1)	Determine current coaching force by sport, level, race, gender, and whether the coaches are employed full-time by schools or are nonfaculty coaches.	
(2)	Study historical trends in demand for coaches and projected need for coaches.	
(3) (4) (5)	Determine current availability and sources for coaches. Identify preservice and ongoing coaching training programs. Review coaching salaries, including comparisons with coaching	
	salaries in other states.
